Keep your Teeth Healthy

On Thursday morning we had a visit from the dental team from Longwell Green Dental Practice. Dan, the dentist, led a presentation to all of the children about how to care for their teeth. The children learnt about which foods contain high levels of sugar, which then produces acid in the mouth and causes cavities in teeth. Two volunteers, Daniel and Alice, were invited to assist two dental nurses with a demonstration. The children filled clear plastic bags with spoonful's of sugar to show us how much sugar is in a range of food. For example:

- 11 teaspoons of sugar in one Mars bar
- 25 teaspoons of sugar in large bag of Haribo
- 11 teaspoons of sugar in a 'Monster' drink
- 7 teaspoons of sugar in a can of coke
