Story Book Selfies

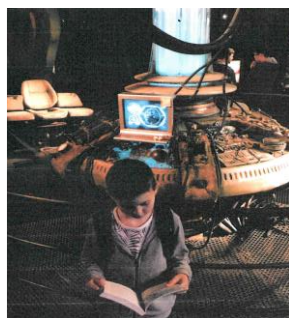
Thank you to all of the children who entered our Story Book Selfie competition. We had some fantastic entries which made judging a very difficult task.
