### Water bottles

Please ensure that your child has a **named** water bottle in school every day to help them to keep hydrated. We do not have water fountains in school and so if they do not have a water bottle, the children can sometimes go the whole morning without a drink. Plastic cups are available if asked for however, for hygiene purposes, a personal bottle is better. Research shows that a well hydrated brain learns more effectively.
