






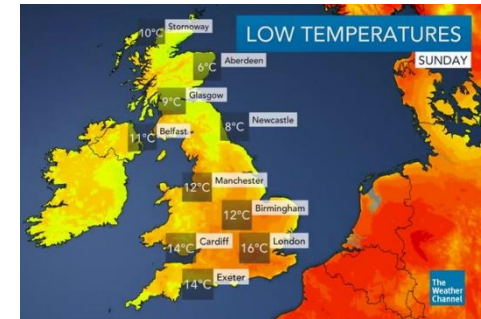


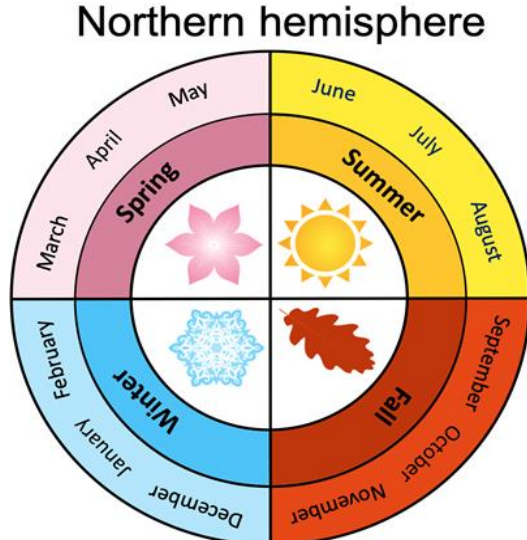
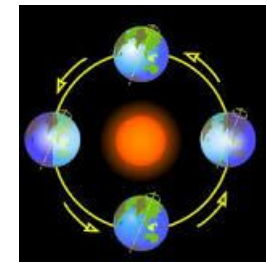
# Vocabulary

	Spring	Is 1 of 4 seasons between Winter and Summer. In England it is warmer, lighter and often new animals are born.
	Summer	The season between Spring and Autumn. In England, it is typically the hottest time of the year.
	Autumn	The colourful season between Summer and Winter. When leaves fall from trees and animals begin hibernation.
	Winter	Between Autumn and Spring. It is usually cold and can often snow in England.
	Weather	The state of the atmosphere. For example sunny, hot, dry, wet or windy.
	Patterns	Weather patterns occur when the weather stays the same for days in a row.
