



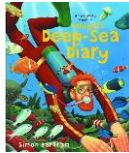
What are Pine Class learning in Term 6?



English

Fiction- Dougal's Deep Sea Diary, children write their own "deep sea diary".
Describing settings underwater. Travel brochure- Come to the Sea!

Poetry- Seaside poems, children create their own poetry based on the seaside.



Science

To work scientifically to record and gather a range of data to answer questions through simple tests.

How can we look after the seaside? (Global)

Which material would make the nest beach?

Which material would be best to make a wind turbine?

Maths

Measurement- choose and use appropriate standard units to estimate and measure length/height in any direction (m/cm); mass (kg/g); temperature (°C); capacity (litres/ml) to reason and problem solve.

Statistics- Interpret and construct simple pictograms, tally charts, block diagrams and simple tables.

Geometry- Use mathematic vocabulary to describe position, direction and movement.
