Communication and Language

Retell the story - once they have developed a deep familiarity with the text; some as exact repetition and some in their own words.

Use new vocabulary in different contexts.

STORY MAPPING

Alternative endings to familiar tales verbally, then challenge to record.

Continuing with our Rocket Phonics scheme.

Writing sentences.

Using finger spaces, full stops and capital letters.
