#### What are we learning next term?

wnat are we learning next term?		
Holly Class	What happens in spring?  The children will be exploring the signs of spring, Easter celebrations including Shrove Tuesday, growing, planting and wildlife we see throughout the season. There will be an 'egg' week, which focusses on new life.	
Hazel Class	When did humans visit space?  The children will learn all about our solar system, the names of the planets and about our star – the sun. The children will research Neil Armstrong and explore the first moon landing in 1969 as well as Tim Peake, a British Astronaut who spent 186 days on board the ISS.	
Pine Class	What happened in the Great Fire of London?  The children will learn about this historical event from 1666. They will look at various sources of information to understand what happened and why. Children will delve into our modern-day emergency services and learn about fire safety.	
Willow Class	What have archaeologists taught us about Ancient Egypt? Year 3 will learn about life in ancient Egypt. They will learn about famous Pharaohs, the pyramids, and the famous written language – hieroglyphics.	
Beech Class	How have Anglo Saxons affected modern day society?  The children will explore the life of Anglo Saxons; their villages, their jobs and how and when they came to invade Britain. Children will use artefacts to explain the Anglo-Saxon culture and how they have influenced how we live our lives today.	
Maple Class	What impact have ancient Greeks had on modern life? With food tasting and dressing up, the maple class children always love learning about ancient Greeks.	
Oak Class	What is around and beyond our planet?  This topic spans two terms due to Year 6 having lot's going on! SATs and camp are big milestones for the oldest children in school.


