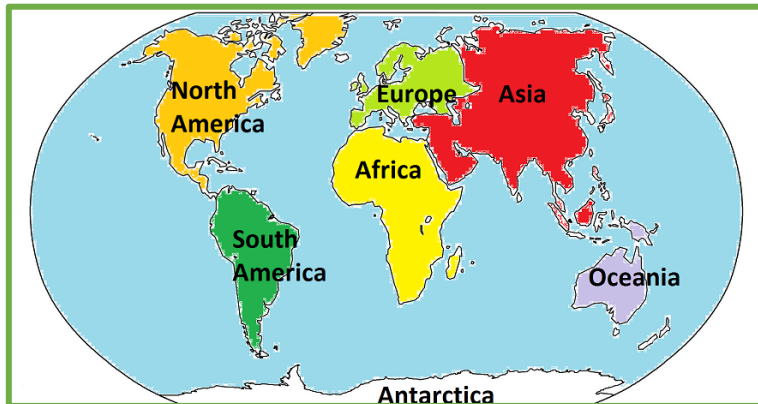


Term 6- Where is Africa?

Sticky Vocabulary

<i>population</i>	Total amount of people living in one place.
<i>arid</i>	A climate with little or no rain.
<i>climate</i>	An area with particular weather and conditions.
<i>equator</i>	The <i>equator</i> is a line drawn around a planet. The <i>equator</i> is halfway between the North Pole and the South Pole.
