## Sticky Vocabulary



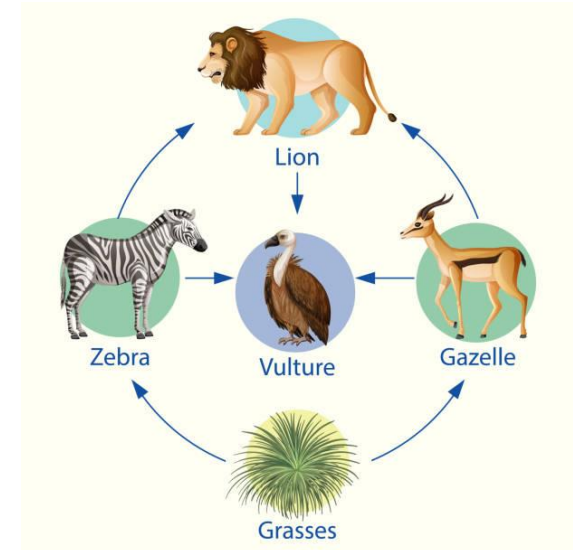
<i>food chain</i>	The order in which living things, depend on each other for food.
<i>predator</i>	An animal that naturally preys on others.
<i>prey</i>	An animal that is hunted and killed by another for food.
<i>habitat</i>	The natural home or environment of an animal, or plant.

In Africa, you will find some of the largest mammals on this planet. Among them are the largest land mammal, the African elephant, the tallest mammal, the giraffe, and the fastest mammal, the cheetah, which can run with speeds up to 113km an hour or 70 miles an hour!

### Did you know ...?



Living things are linked through their food. For example, a lion, a zebra and grass are linked because the lion eats the zebra and the zebra eats the grass. These links are called **food chains**. Many food chains may be joined together to form a **food web**.
