We have been practising our footwork in PE. Some of the footwork is tricky but we have recognised what we have improved and what needs further practice.

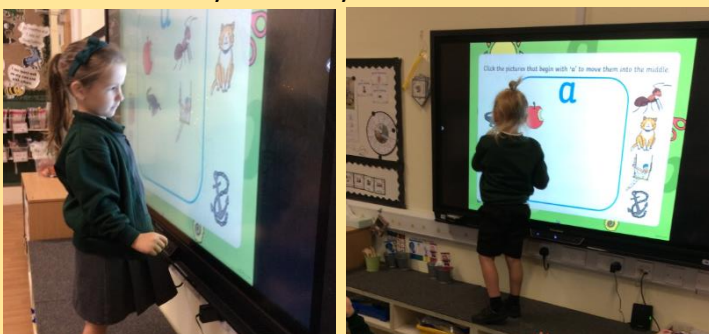


In Science, we have tested rock properties by rubbing with sandpaper, scratching with coins, dripping water over and placing in a bucket of water. It was fun! 😊

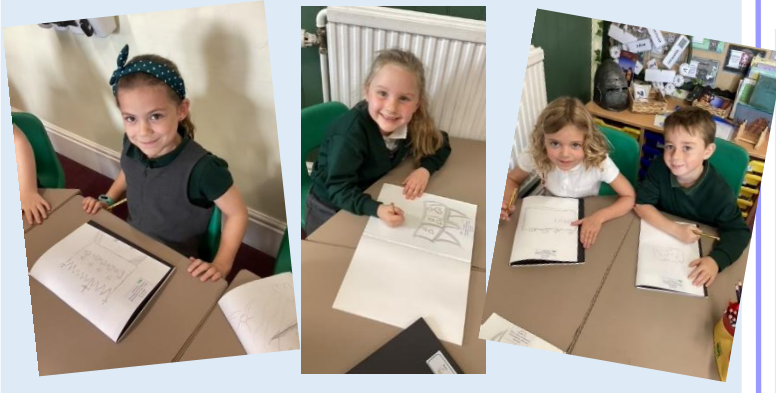


## Learning in Pine Class

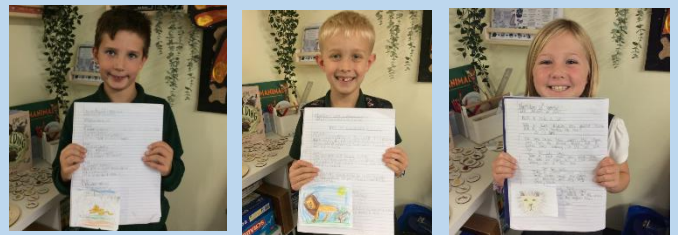
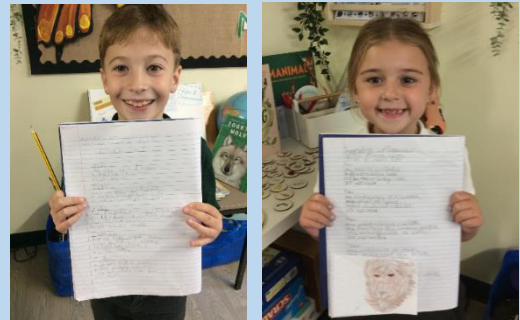


In Art Year 2 have been practising a forwards and backwards sketching technique to sketch a crown. This was quite tricky, but they will be practising this skill for a few weeks!
