
Learning in Pine Class

Learning in Beech Class

In maths this week, the children in Year 4 have been learning about area. Area is the measurement of space inside a 2D shape. Beech Class explored using different non-standard units to measure the area of shapes. They agreed that the unit needed to be consistent otherwise the measurements were not accurate and different members of the class came up with different answers when they were measuring the same thing. Using the squares in our books, we were able to accurately measure and compare the area of 2D shapes.



The children also explored how our times tables can help us by recognising that we can calculate area by multiplying the length by the width of rectangular shapes.

Learning in Oak Class

This week in Year 6, we started their fundraising project, with the aim of raising as much money as they possibly can for their trip to London at the end of the year.
