Learning in Maple Class

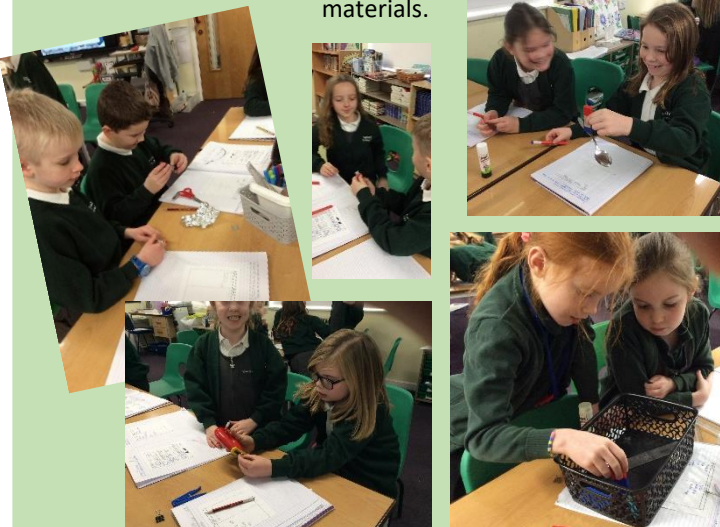

Learning in Beech Class

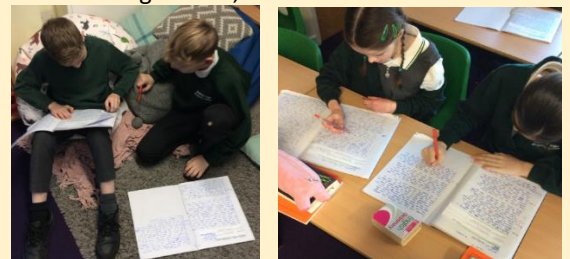
This week, Beech class have continued their RE unit on Judaism by learning about the special festival of Passover. This is a time when Jews remember how Moses led the early Jewish people to freedom.



One of the ways they celebrate is with a large family dinner called the Seder meal. At the Seder meal, a special plate called the Seder plate is used. We looked at the different foods on the Seder plate and what special part of this Jewish story they represent.

Learning in Oak Class

We have also been busy with creative writing. We were tasked with planning and writing our own narratives and were allowed to use our imagination to create our own unique stories.

Learning in Holly Class

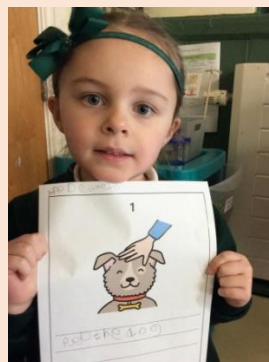

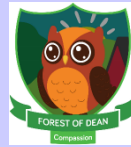
In Art, the children have spent time revisiting the primary colours before moving onto mixing secondary colours and experimenting how many shades we can make of a secondary colour, green.
