The children competed in shot put, discus and long jump to name a few. In the afternoon, we held our traditional races. The children in KS1 used the straight track, running sprint races against their classmates. Those who came 1st and 2nd then competed for the title **fastest boy** and **fastest girl** in KS1.

At the very end of the afternoon, we had a whole school obstacle race, which had a child from each class for each house take part. Starting with Holly class, they completed the track before handing over to Hazel class and then Pine all the way up to oak class.

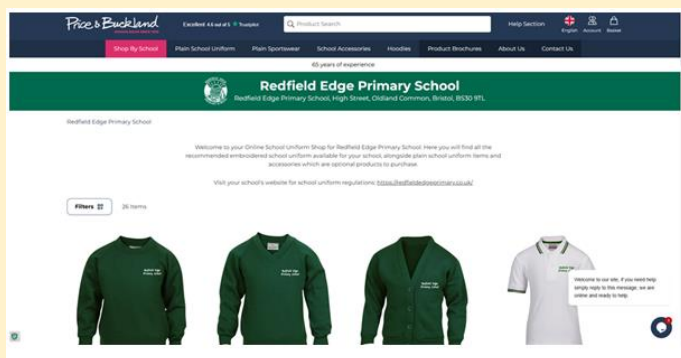
We have some school uniform news.
