USEFUL INFORMATION

TOAST

25p per day.

Please pay termly online via Arbor.

DINNER MONEY

£2.90 per day.

All school dinners are paid for online via Arbor.

Please let the School Office know if you are receiving any benefits as you may be entitled to free school meals.

OVER 5's MILK

Once your child turns 5 you will need to start paying for them to receive milk in school. This can be ordered and paid for at www.schoolmilkservices.co.uk

TRIPS

Trip details and payments will be on Arbor.

All trips are funded by voluntary donations. These should be paid via the online payment system.

SCHOOL MONEY

Payments for dinners, trips, toast etc can also be made online on Arbor with a debit or credit card. Log in details will be provided.

ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL

An absence form needs to be completed prior to any period of absence other than medical. Family holidays will be unauthorised.

BREAKFAST CLUB

Run by the school with school employees. Charge is £4.50 per day. There will be a choice of cereals, toast, crumpets and drinks for your child to choose from. This can be booked in advance via Arbor.

AFTER SCHOOL CLUB

This club is run by school staff and costs £7.50 until 4.30pm or 5pm, or £9 until 5.30pm or 6pm. Your child will be offered a snack which may include fruit, toast, yogurt and squash. This can be booked via Arbor.

AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS – RUN BY THE SCHOOL

Some teachers run clubs for the children to attend. These vary from term to term and need to be booked in advance. An email with details will be sent via Arbor at the end of every other term. Clubs are not offered to children in Reception.

CAKE SALES

Throughout the year each class has at least one cake sale to raise money to buy games, books etc. for their classroom. These resources can then be used for example during wet play. Parents and carers are asked to bring in cakes which are sold by parent volunteers in the playground after school.

NUT FREE SCHOOL

We are a completely nut free school, please ensure that your child's lunch box and snacks do not contain nuts.

BOOK FAIR

Each year, usually in November, the Travelling Book Fair visit us and parents can come in after school and buy books. This is also accompanied by Book at Bedtime when children can come into school between 5 and 6pm, in their PJ's and members of staff read to groups of children.

PARENTS EVENINGS

These usually take place twice a year and parents are invited into speak with their child's class teacher. Appointments will be bookable through Arbor.
