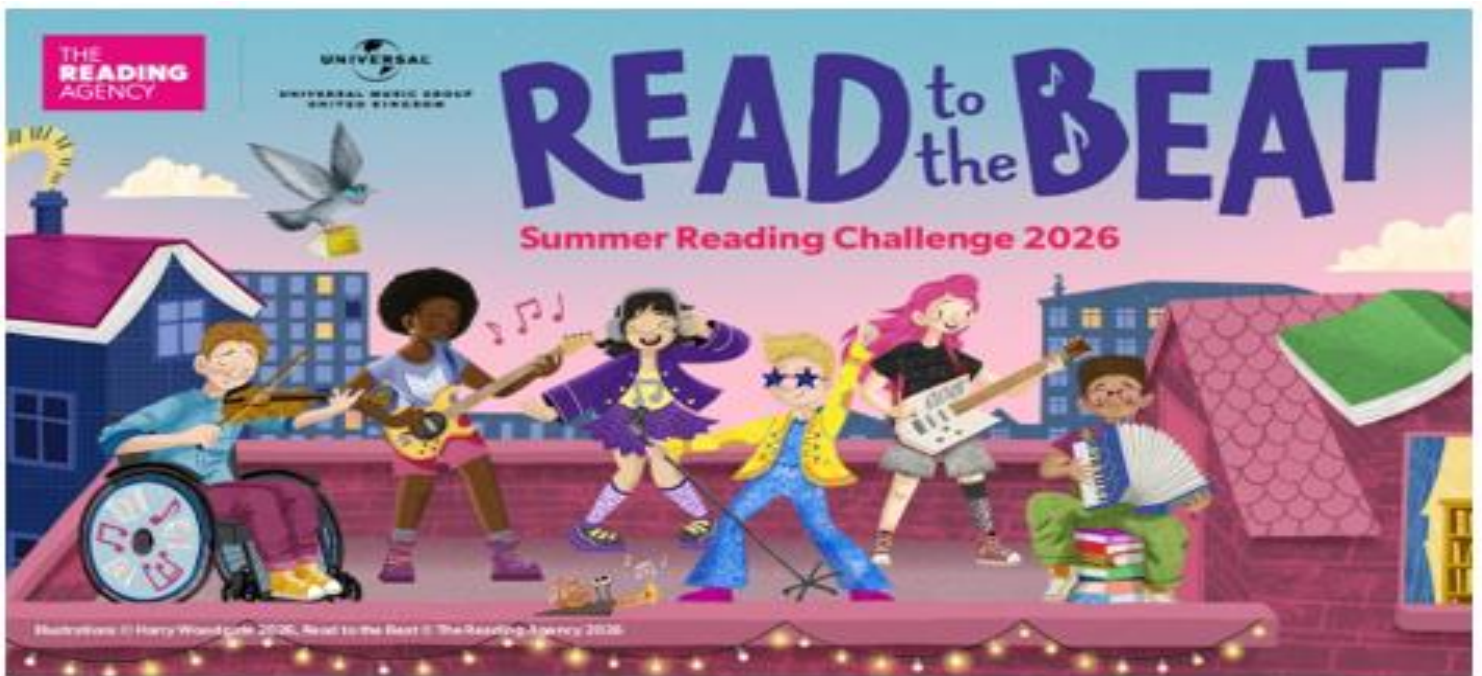


Each class took it in turns to run around the track, tackling the inflatable, the obstacles and the water! It was so much fun!



SAFETY IN THE SUN!



It's important that we all stay safe in the sun.
Follow these simple tips to help keep you and
your family safe and well in hot weather.

NHS ADVICE: HOW TO STAY SAFE IN THE SUN

Extreme heat can affect anyone. Follow these simple tips to help keep you and your family safe and well.

1 SLIP ON SUNSCREEN



Use at least SPF 30, high protection sunscreen. Apply generously and regularly - every 2 hours and after swimming or sweating.

2 COVER UP



Wear loose fitting, light clothing, a wide-brimmed hat and sunglasses to protect your skin and eyes.

3 SEEK SHADE



Stay in the shade when you can, especially between 11am and 3pm when the sun is strongest.

4 KEEP HYDRATED



Drink plenty of fluids - water is best. Don't wait until you feel thirsty. Avoid excess caffeine and alcohol.

5 CHECK ON OTHERS



Look out for family, friends and neighbours, especially older people, young children and those with health conditions.

6 NEVER LEAVE ANYONE IN A CAR



Cars can heat up quickly, even with the windows open. Never leave children or pets in a car.



Look out for the signs of heat exhaustion and heatstroke: headache, dizziness, feeling sick, confusion, rapid heartbeat, flushed skin or feeling very hot.
