We wanted the occasion to feel less rushed and for each child to have the opportunity to take part in more races and I believe we achieved this.

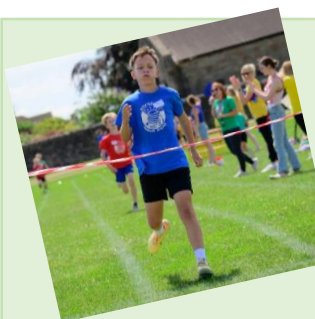

We then headed to Drury Lane Theatre to watch the incredible production of **Hercules**.

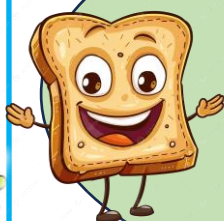

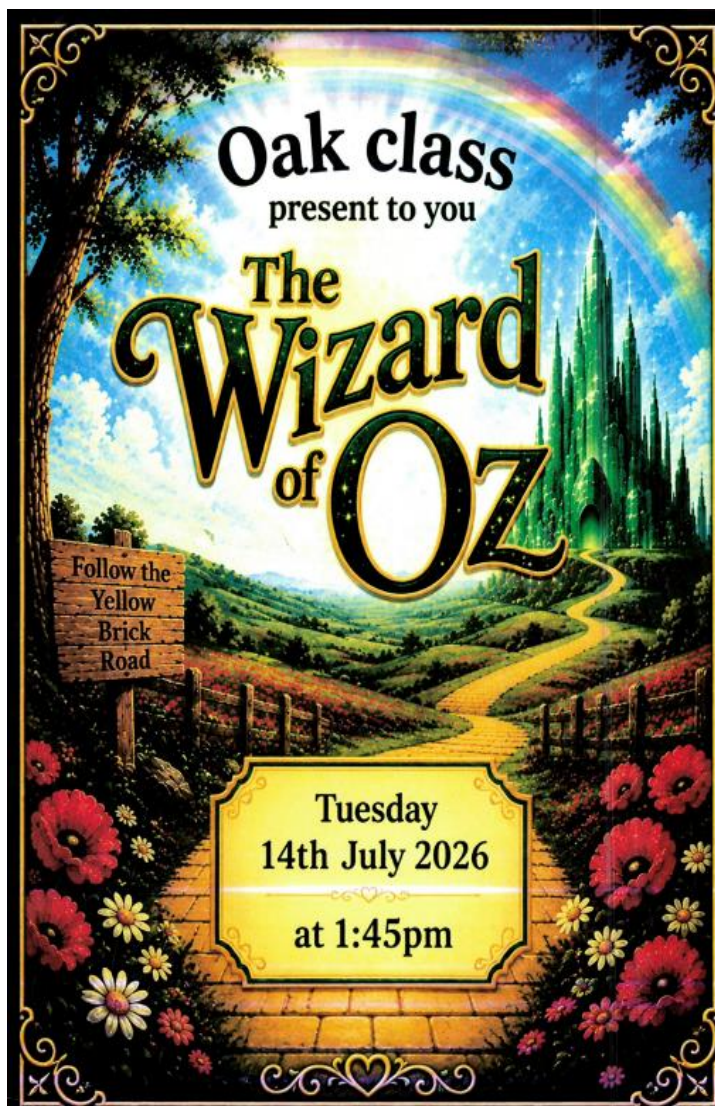
